This term our theme is the great outdoors and the children are enjoying being outside and exploring the natural world. We will continue to observe the seeds we have planted and watch them change over

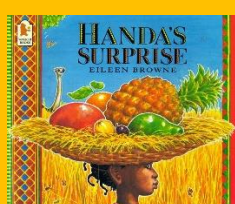
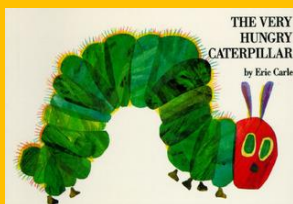
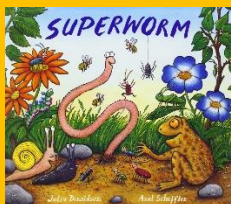
time. We will also be looking at the insects and wildlife that lives around us, especially in the front garden and at the nature trail and creating a garden centre role-play area outside.
